

Neutral Noel Single Step Card Tutorial

Supplies and Cutting Instructions

In addition to the cardstock listed below, you will need the Welcome Noel Bundle, the Noel Tidings Stamp Set, the Pecan Pie and Mossy Meadow Classic Stampin' Pads, a Paper Trimmer, a Bone folder and your adhesive of choice - I used Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

Pecan Pie Cardstock

- Card Base: 28 cm x 10.5 cm.
- Back panel piece: 10.5 cm x 10.5 cm
- Back mat sentiment layer: 4 cm x 9.5 cm
- House: 4.5 cm x 6.5 cm

Mossy Meadow Cardstock

- Middle mat piece – 9.5 cm x 7cm
- Front mat sentiment layer – 9.5 cm x 1.5 cm

Gold Timeless Metallic Specialty Paper

- House: 4.5 cm x 6.5 cm
- Stars: 5 cm x 3 cm

Basic White Cardstock

- Back mat: 10 cm x 10 cm
- Middle tree mat: 10 cm x 7 cm
- Middle house mat and sentiment: 9.5 cm x 4 cm
- Front mat house border: 10 cm x 5.5 cm
- Front mat sentiment: 1 cm x 9 cm
- Reverse back panel mat: 10 cm x 6 cm
- Trees: 15 cm x 4.5 cm

Method

1. Using the Paper Trimmer, score the card base along the long side at 3.2 cm, 6.4 cm, 10.8 cm 15.2 cm and 21.5 cm.
2. Use the bone folder to fold along score lines of the card base to create a concertina style fold.
3. Die cut the trees and houses onto the Basic White cardstock pieces following the cutting instructions above to ensure you are cutting the right piece of cardstock. NOTE: Place the tree die and house die along the top side of the long edge of the cardstock.
4. Stamp houses, trees and sentiments in Pecan Pie.
5. Using the 15 cm x 4.5 cm Basic White cardstock strip, stamp two small trees and one large tree in Mossy Meadow and then die cut the trees.
6. Die cut the Pecan Pie house using both the wide house outline die and the embossed detail die.
7. Die cut 6 stars and the wide house outline from the Gold Timeless Metallic Specialty Paper.
8. Adhere all pieces to the card base, following the photos as a guide for assembly.

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
